Q: What is The Green Team?

A: The Green Team is a summer youth job program designed to put YOU to work in the environment!

Q: Who is eligible to apply?

A: Anyone ages 18-24 residing in San Diego County.

Q: How much will I get paid and for how long?

A: \$8.00/hour for up to 159 hours over 5 weeks.

Q: What type of work will I be doing?

A: All jobs focus on environmental preservation. You will be working outdoors clearing brush, building trails, planting trees, recycling and more!

Q: How can I apply?

A: Apply in person at Urban Corps located at 3127 Jefferson St. San Diego, CA 92110. For more info call (619) 235-6884 and ask for the HIRE-A-YOUTH program or via email at agonzalez@urbancorps.org

Am I Qualified?

- **Must be 18-24 year's old**
- **Must meet low-income guidelines (see chart below) and have at least one defined employment barrier as listed below:**
 - **Have a Disability**
 - **Limited English Proficiency**
 - **Gang Affiliated**
 - **Refugee/Immigrant**
 - **Foster Youth**
 - **Have a Parent in Jail**
 - **Offender**
 - **Parents out of Work for 15 weeks**
 - **Pregnant or Parenting (under 22)**
 - **Substance Abuse**
 - **Risk of Dropping Out**
 - **Being Raised by Someone Other than your Parent**

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS: Valid Picture ID and a signed Social Security Card

Please Bring as Many of the Following Documents as Possible:

- Transcripts, IEP, or any Standardized Test from last school attended
- High School Transcripts
- Health & Human Services Documents, Letter from Agency
- Birth Certificate or Declaration of Paternity
- Court Documents - Adjudication paper work or fines
- Report Card
- Medical Records, doctors reports, HHS documents
- EAC, Permanent or Resident card, Immigration Documents
- DD-214 Discharge Papers, Military Records
- Proof of Registration for Selective Service

Income Eligibility Documents (bring all available)

- Recent Pay Stubs
- 2009 Income tax forms (yours, or parents' if dependant)
- HHS, Welfare or Disability Documents
- Income Verification Letter

1	\$1,805.00	\$21,660
2	\$2,428.33	\$29,140
3	\$3,051.66	\$36,620
4	\$3,675.00	\$44,100
5	\$4,298.33	\$51,580
6	\$4,921.66	\$59,060
7	\$5,545.00	\$66,540
8	\$6,168.33	\$74,020

For Family units with more than 8 members, add \$7,480 to the Annual Income for each additional member.
