Tree Smart is a 60-minute presentation and interactive activity designed to teach children the importance and benefits of trees as well as the dangers of trees planted in the wrong places. Material is targeted at students in K through 6th grades. Each presentation is free of charge and lasts approximately 45 to 60 minutes including an interactive LEGO activity in which students design and build a neighborhood with buildings adequate distance from trees. Presentations can be delivered wherever they are most convenient. An audience of 20 to 35 is preferred due to the interactive nature of the materials.
